## INCREASE WORKING MOTHER KNOWLEDGE ABOUT ASIP MANAGEMENT

## **ESSENCE**

Background : The practice of breastfeeding in Indonesia is still relatively low. Central Java Province occupies the 20th position with a percentage of 64.19%. One of the problems related to the low achievement of exclusive breastfeeding is that there are still companies that employ women who don't provide opportunities for mothers who have babies 0-6 months to carry out exclusive breastfeeding. Actually, working mothers can still give breast milk to their babies by expressing the milk. *Expressed milk can be stored in the refrigerator or freezer. Exclusive breastfeeding* requires good management and planning in the breastfeeding process.
