SUMMARY

Background: Hypertension is an increase in systolic blood pressure of more than 140 mmHg and diastolic blood pressure of 90 mmHg on two measurements with an interval of five minutes in a state of rest / calm (Kemenkes RI, 2013). According to WHO (World Health Organization) in Nugroho (2013) the life cycle of the elderly is age 45-60 years (middle age), 60-75 years old (elderly), 75-90 years old (old), age over 90 years (very old). The phenomenon of hypertension in Indonesia is 9.5% diagnosed by health workers or currently taking medication by 9.4% (Trihono, 2013) showing that many hypertensive patients still use medication by means of pharmacological therapy. In addition to pharmacological therapy, non-pharmacological therapy can reduce high blood pressure in hypertensive patients. One of the non-pharmacological therapies that can lower blood pressure is deep breath relaxation therapy and rose aroma therapy. The media used is video media.
