

**IMPROVEMENT OF KNOWLEDGE THROUGH MEDIA BOOKLETS
ABOUT THE GAME TOOLS EDUCATIVE TO IMPROVE THE
DEVELOPMENT OF FINE MOTOR
TODDLER AGE CHILDREN**

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SUMMARY

The Ministry of Health of the Republic of Indonesia reports that 0.4 million (16%) Indonesian children under five have developmental disorders, both fine motor development, gross hearing loss, low intelligence and speech delays. The problem was found due to the lack of stimulation given by parents to children to train the fine motor development of toddlers. Based on these problems, the writer has an idea or ideas by making a booklet entitled "Practicing Fine Motor Development of Toddlers with Educational Games".

The booklet is expected to increase parents' knowledge about how to stimulate the child's fine motor development. A booklet of fine motoric development is a flipchart that contains understanding of development, factors that influence development, understanding of fine motor development, educational play tools, and stimulation of child development. The booklet was chosen as an effective health education medium to provide information to parents and increase their parents' knowledge on how to practice fine motor development for toddlers.
