## EDUCATION ABOUT RANGE OF MOTION (ROM) IN FAMILIES WITH STROKE PATIENTS

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## **SUMMARY**

Back Ground: Low and middle income countries account for 70% of all strokes, which also account for 87% of stroke-related deaths and years of life adjusted for disability. In the last four decades the incidence of stroke has decreased by 42% in high-income countries. In low- and middle-income countries the number has more than doubled. The results of the study in stroke patients showed that family knowledge of ROM was in the poor category (86.7%) and the rest was in the moderate category (13.3%). Method: Using the selected booklet as a medium of communication in providing health information to stroke patients. Result: The resulting project is a media booklet as a media for stroke patient education in an effort to increase muscle strength with ROM exercises so as not to experience muscle weakness. Conclusion: The booklet was chosen as a communication medium to make it easier for the author to provide information to families who have stroke patients and the general public about post-stroke management, which are equipped with illustrated images that make it easier for readers to understand the material.
