SUMMARY

Background: Fires can occur anywhere, be it forest, urban, residential or in office buildings. Based on data from the National Disaster Management Agency (BNPB), there were 1336 cases of residential fires that occurred in Indonesia from 2011-2018. For 2020 the DKI Jakarta Provincial Fire and Rescue Service recorded 243 fires or an average of 4 fires per day. According to the Central Java BPBD in January-April 2018 the number of fire incidents reached 58 incidents with a total loss of 2.16 billion rupiah.
