

EFFORTS TO TREAT FEBRILE SEIZURE IN TODDLERS WITH BOOKLET MEDIA

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SUMMARY

Background: Febrile seizures are a common health problem in childhood between the ages of 6 months to 5 years. Febrile seizures occur because of high fever in children, not because of an intracranial infectious process. Based on the results of the 2019 RI Ministry of Health report, in Indonesia the incidence of febrile seizures was recorded at 14,252 patients. In Central Java, the prevalence of febrile seizures is 2-5% annually. Febrile seizures if not treated quickly and appropriately can affect the quality of life in children **Objective:** by providing education about febrile seizures can provide knowledge about febrile seizures and their proper management. **Methods:** providing health education for febrile seizure with booklet media. **Results:** The community, especially parents and child caretakers, are able to recognize febrile seizures and treat them appropriately. **Conclusion:** The content of the material in this booklet can be used as a guide and applied independently by the reader as an alternative in the initial treatment of febrile seizures in toddlers at home.
