

DESCRIPTION OF PARENT PARENTING PATTERNS IN CHILDREN PRE-SCHOOL IN KINDERGARTEN PERTIWI 03 MATESIH

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ABSTRACT

Background : parenting style can be defined as a pattern of interaction between children and parents which includes the fulfillment of physical needs and psychological needs. In other words, parenting also includes patterns of interaction between parents and children in the framework of children's character education. So the style played by parents in developing children's characteristics is very important between authoritarian, democratic and permissive. The prevalence of the number of preschool children in the matesih sub-district was recorded at 5,783 children. parenting styles for their children are different, there are several parenting styles that are applied by parents to children who are not suitable for children who look gloomy, grumpy, like to fight with friends and siblings, some even don't want to go to school. **Objective :** To find out the description of parenting styles for pre-school aged children in TK Pertiwi 03 Matesih, Matesih District, Karanganyar Regency. **Method :** The type of research used is descriptive quantitative survey method. Results: 14 (33.3) respondents had permissive parenting, 22 (52.4) respondents had democratic parenting, and 6 (14.3) respondents had authoritarian parenting. The results showed that the highest parenting style was democratic and the lowest was authoritarian parenting. **Conclusion :** An overview of parenting styles for preschool-age children in Mother Nature Kindergarten 03 with a democratic majority.
