

HEALTH REPRODUCTION STATUS DESCRIPTION OF FEMALE ADOLESCENTS AT SMP N 1 MANTINGAN

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ABSTRACT

Background: Adolescence is a transitional period between childhood and adulthood marked by sexual maturity. Currently, adolescents in Indonesia are increasingly vulnerable to various health risks, especially those related to sexual and reproductive health. According to data from the Central Statistics Agency (BPS), the number of adolescents aged 15-19 years in 2022 reached 22,176,543 individuals or 8.05% of Indonesia's total population. The World Health Organization (WHO) emphasizes the importance of reproductive health education for early adolescents aged 10-14 years. **Objective:** To determine the reproductive health status of female adolescents at SMPN 1 Mantingan. **Methods:** The type of research used in this study used quantitative research with a descriptive approach with a sample of 60 respondents. Using a questionnaire that guides health screening techniques and periodic examinations of school-age children and adolescents. **Results:** The reproductive health status, the data indicates that most of them have poor reproductive health, with many experiencing issues like vaginal discharge and itching in the genital area. This condition requires more intensive attention and socialization efforts to improve the knowledge and reproductive health of adolescents in the school. **Conclusion:** The reproductive health status of female adolescents at SMPN 1 Mantingan is dominated by the "less healthy" category, with 37 respondents or 61.7% experiencing less favorable reproductive health conditions.
