DESCRIPTION OF KNOWLEDGE LEVEL OF FIRST AID FIRST AID OF SPLINT DRESSING IN PMR MEMBERS IN SMP N 1 MASARAN

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ABSTRACT

Background: The incidence of accidents among students is the highest at 13%, so YRC members need knowledge or skills in providing First Aid. The number of accidents in Indonesia that cause fractures is still relatively high at 60.9%. In general, fractures that often occur at school occur in the musculoskeletal system. Objective: To determine the level of knowledge of YRC members on first aid bandaging at SMP N 1 Masaran. **Methods:** Quantitative research with descriptive methods using a cross-sectional approach. The sample selection in this study used total sampling with a total sample size of 58 respondents. Data collection used a questionnaire on the level of knowledge of splint dressing. Data were analysed using Univariate Test. **Results:** The results showed that most respondents had a poor level of knowledge as much as 69%, a sufficient level of knowledge as much as 22.4% and a good level of knowledge as much as 8.6%. **Conclusion:** The level of knowledge in this study showed that most respondents had a poor level of knowledge.
