ABSTRACT

The *E-Learning* system is an online learning system that was officially created and has been used for several years at 'Aisyiyah University Surakarta. With this system, it is hoped that the implementation of lectures can be made easier; this e-learning system has not yet undergone a user satisfaction evaluation. The purpose of this research is to evaluate the level of user satisfaction with e-learning. This research uses the End User Computing Satisfaction (EUCS) method, which includes 5 variables with a total of 100 respondents from 'Aisyiyah University Surakarta. Of the 5 variables, the one with the highest percentage result is the *content* variable, with 80% rated as Very Satisfied, followed by the *accuracy* variable at 71% rated as Satisfied, the *format* variable also at 71% rated as Satisfied, the *ease of use* variable at 77% rated as Very Satisfied, and the *timeliness* variable at 71% rated as Satisfied. With these percentage results, there are 2 variables rated as Very Satisfied and 3 variables rated as Satisfied. Therefore, the *e-learning* system has met user satisfaction.
