SUMMARY

Background: Burns are a common problem in society. According to data from the World Health Organization (WHO), it is estimated that every year there are 11 million burn injuries worldwide, with 180,000 of them being fatal. In addition, the American Burn Association shows that data on burn cases continues and is the main cause of unintentional accidents. In Indonesia itself, burns are the 6th cause of accidents. Housewives are vulnerable to being the most victims of burns because they are in direct contact with fire sources every day. **Objective:** To provide information to the public about proper first aid for burns and not to use materials that worsen the victim's condition. **Method:** First aid for burn care for housewives is delivered using a booklet entitled 'Burns Don't Panic: A Quick Solution for Great Mothers'. **Results:** The A4-sized booklet consisting of 10 sheets is new and has never been published in any media.
