

# ***TRAUMA HEALING POST DISASTER EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN WITH VIDEO MEDIA***

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## ***SUMMARY***

***Background:*** Natural disasters in Indonesia, such as floods, earthquakes and volcanic eruptions, often cause serious psychological impacts on child victims. Trauma experienced by children after disasters can interfere with their psychological and social development if not addressed immediately. The prevalence of children experiencing post-disaster trauma was recorded to be quite high, namely 14.89% in Lombok, 21.7% in Taiwan, and 16.7% in Sukoharjo, so that psychological handling of children after disasters is very important. However, the knowledge and skills of disaster officers and volunteers in providing first psychological help to children are still limited. ***Objective:*** Produce educational video media with the title “Post Disaster Trauma Healing Education for Children with Video Media” to increase the knowledge and insight of disaster workers and volunteers about handling psychotherapy for children affected by disasters. ***Method:*** Videos are used to provide insight information and increase the knowledge of disaster workers and volunteers about handling psychotherapy in children. ***Results:*** IEC media in the form of videos, containing information designed to equip volunteers with basic skills in providing psychological first aid to children. ***Conclusion:*** This video media is expected to facilitate the delivery of insight information and knowledge to disaster workers regarding psychological handling in post-disaster children.
