

***THE APPLICATION OF THE TECHNIQUE OF REBUKING THE ABILITY  
TO CONTROL AUDITORY HALLUCINATIONS IN SCHIZOPHRENIA  
PATIENTS IN THE SENA ROOM OF DR. ARIF ZAINUDIN SURAKARTA  
HOSPITAL***

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***ABSTRACT***

***Background*** : Schizophrenia is a serious mental illness that reduces a person's ability to control their emotions, behavior, and brain function, all of which affect their thinking. The scolding technique is an independent action that can be applied to control patient hallucinations without involving others. The ability to control hallucinations is influenced by several factors, including the duration of illness or hospitalization. ***Objective*** : To determine the outcome of implementing the Scolding Technique on the ability to control auditory hallucinations in patients with schizophrenia at Sena Room, Dr. Arif Zainudin Surakarta Psychiatric Hospital. ***Method*** : This study used a case study design with a descriptive research method. There were 2 respondents, and the intervention was conducted for 3 days. ***Results*** : Patients' hallucinations before the scolding technique intervention were in the poor ability category. After the intervention, patients' hallucinations improved to the good control ability category. There was a comparison between before and after the scolding technique intervention. ***Conclusion*** : There is an increase in the ability to control hallucinations after applying the scolding technique.
