SUMMARY

Background: Hospitals are one of the health care facilities that have a high risk of spreading infections due to the high population of bacteria and viruses that cause disease. Infectious diseases that occur in health services are called Health-care Associated Infections (HAIS). One of the media for nosocomial infections is the patient's family who does not comply with infection prevention behavior.
