APPLICATION OF CLEAN PAINT CARE USING TRANSPARANT FILM ON THE PROCESS WELDING HEALING IN POST PATIENTS SECTIO CAESAREA OPERATIONS IN THE AREA KLUMPRIT VILLAGE

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ABSTRACT

Background: Post surgical caesarean section requires proper wound care to prevent infection. Wound care procedures must be carried out in accordance with the SOP, the purpose of which is to speed up the healing process and be free from infection from wounds caused by nosocomial infections. The principle of wound care, namely maintaining the physiology of moisture in the wound environment, so that it can trigger the process of tissue repair. Transparant wrapping has the properties of being resistant to water, semi-occlusive which means that water and gas can pass through the surface of the dressing, so that it can retain moisture in the environment around the wound. **Objective**: To describe the results of differences before and after the application of transparant wound dressing care to the wound healing process in patients with sectio caesarean surgery. Methods: This study used a case study and descriptive method with 2 respondents. Results: There were differences in wound healing processes before and after the application of clean wound treatment using transparant dressing on both respondents. The difference in the wound healing process lies in the application of the first day to the third day. Conclusion: In this study it was proven that the application of clean wound treatment using transparant dressing was able to accelerate the wound healing process.
