FACTORS THAT AFFECT STUNTING IN CHILD

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SUMMARY

The undernourishment status in pregnant mothers and infant is the main factor in stunting children. Stunting is a toddler with a short condition that is marked when a child's length or height is inferior to his or her age. Many toddlers are stunted, since many parents are unaware of what factors can cause stunting.

The poster media on the factors associated with this stunting event was selected as information medium to make it easier for authors to convey health information about the factors associated with stunting events to the public especially in pregnant mothers and parents. This poster benefited many parties, including many in the general public, which can help to shed information on stunting factors and as stunting prevention efforts for toddlers. In addition, for medical center or posyandu it is expected to add additional information and input to a stunting prevention effort. With a poster for the factors associated with this stunting event, it is hoped to reduce stunting events in toddlers.
