## Family Education About Wound Care Methods To Prevent Infection of Postoperative Patients Through Booklet Media

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## **SUMMARY**

**Background**; Post surgery is a condition after surgery and medical treatment to repair damaged tissue or organs, surgery can pose a risk of surgical wound infection, which is one of the post-operative complications characterized by pain, pus and edema. There are several risk factors that cause postoperative wound infection, one of which is the postoperative factor, namely wound care. Conclusion; With the media booklet, it can increase knowledge to the community, especially the patient's family, about care management which is useful for preventing wound infection in postoperative patients.
