IMPLEMENTATION OF THE USE OF HONEY IN THE PROCESS OF HEALING MELLITUS DIABETES THROUGH MEDIA BOOKLET

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SUMMARY

Background: Diabetes mellitus increases every year the number diagnosed with diabetes mellitus and some even experience complications. Clients who suffer from DM with ulcer complications have reached 80%. One alternative to diabetic wound care is honey therapy. Based on research on 20 patients who came to the Omah Luka clinic in Surakarta, it was concluded that honey has the benefit of helping the healing process of gangrene wounds in diabetes mellitus patients, within 2 weeks granulation tissue has started to appear. It is proven that honey can accelerate healing of DM wound. Methods: Information about the importance of wound care in the wound healing process is socialized through the media, one of which is a booklet. Booklet media is a health promotion media that aims to convey information to the public in printed form. Result: The booklet title "MADU PENYEMBUH LUKAMU" Yuk, Lindungi Tubuhmu Dari Diabetes Mellitus, was created using a design application with a size of 3.5 x 8.5 inches which consists of 24 pages. Conclusion: honey therapy is very helpful in the patient's diabetic wound healing process, so it is hoped that this therapy can be used as an alternative treatment for diabetic wound healing.
