DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY PREPAREDNESS ATTITUDES FOR FLOOD EVENTS IN TANGKIL VILLAGE, SRAGEN SUB-DISTRICT, SRAGEN REGENCY

ABSTRACT

Background: Flood disaster is a natural disaster that often occurs, especially in the village of Tangkil, Sragen Regency. Therefore, knowledge is needed about the attitude of preparedness of the people of the Tangkil village to deal with flood disasters in the village. According to the BPBD (Regional Disaster Management Agency) of Sragen district, the factors that influenced the occurrence of flooding in Sragen Regency, especially in the Tangkil village, were the opening of the Gajah Mungkur reservoir floodgates in the Wonogiri area and high rainfall in the Klaten, Solo and Karanganyar areas. This resulted in the overflow of the Bengawan Solo river water plus water from the Gajah Mungkur reservoir and a tributary around the Tangkil village called the Mungkung River overflowed and caused flooding in the Tangkil village. Purpose: To find out the description of the attitude of the community in the village of Tangkil preparedness against floods. Method: This type of research is quantitative with a cross sectional approach. The number of samples obtained from the calculation of the Slovin formula is as many as 60 respondents. Results: Knowledge of the preparedness of the heads of the Tangkil village families in dealing with flood disasters is included in the very prepared category. This is evidenced by the fact that 60 respondents chose to agree on flood preparedness with a percentage of 100%. Conclusion: The preparedness of the heads of the Tangkil family towards facing flooding is in the very good and very prepared category.
