DESCRIPTION OF MOTHER'S LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE ABOUT FIRST AID FOR BURNS TODDLER AGE CHILDREN IN BEDORO VILLAGE

ABSTRACT

Background: Mothers knowledge is an important factor in treating burns in toddler. Inappropriate initial treatment can have detrimental effects on burn sufferers. It is known that in Indonesia burn injuries reach 9.2% and burns are one of the injuries that often occur in toddler. Objective: To know the mothers knowledge level regarding first aid of burns for toddler in Bedoro Village. Method: Quantitative research with descriptive methods using a cross-sectional. Sample selectioned using Total Sampling with a total sample was 123 respondents. Collecting data in this study using a questionnaire on the knowledge. The data were analyzed using Univariate Test. Results: Research shows that 75.6% of respondents had minus knowledge level, 9.8% of respondents had a good knowledge level. The characteristics of the respondents showed that 56.9% were aged 26-35 years, 61.8% had a high school education, 52% were housewives, 77.2% of respondents had no experience caring for burns, respondents had never received information about help. the first burn injury was 77.2%. Conclusion: Most of the respondents knowledge level fell into the less category.
