THE RELATIONSHIP OF HUSBAND'S SUPPORT WITH STUNTING PREVENTION BEHAVIOR IN CHILDREN AGED 0-24 MONTHS IN THEREGIONPAJANG HEALTH CENTER WORK

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ABSTRACT

Background: Stunting in toddlers is caused by many factors such as socioeconomic conditions, maternal nutrition during pregnancy, pain in babies, and lack of nutritional intake in babies. The city of Surakarta is ranked 2nd highest in Central Java, namely 20.4% in 2021. The husband's support that mothers receive in preventing stunting has a positive effect on the mother's experience by influencing the amount of breast milk the mother produces. **Objective**: To determine the relationship between husband's support and stunting prevention behavior in children aged 0-24 months in the Pajang health center working area. Method: This research uses a descriptive analytical method with a cross sectional approach with a correlation design, using a purposive sampling technique with a population of 84 respondents consisting of families with children aged 0-24 months in the Pajang Region. **Results**: The category of husband's support for mothers who have children aged 0-24 months in the Pajang health center working area is in the good category, namely 49 people or 58.3%. Conclusion: The majority of husbands' support for mothers who have children aged 0-24 months in the Pajang Community Health Center work area have good husband support.
