Background: Early marriage or young marriage is not a new phenomenon in Indonesia, even for a long time, the number of early marriages in the world is 14.2 million. Indonesia will be one of the world's fourth highest early marriages by 2023. The village of Jrakah is one of the villages with a high rate of early marriages, with 166 cases in 2023. The Objective researh: To understand adolescent girls' knowledge of early marriage in Jrakah Village, Gesikan Hamlet, Selo Boyolali District. Method: his study uses a quantitative descriptive method with a sample number of 30 and a respondent number of 62, using total sampling techniques. With certain inclusion and exclusion criteria. **Results**: Results of the survey characteristics of respondents by age, teenagers aged 15-17 with a total of 31 respondents (60.8%). Results from the study characteristics respondents based on the education of adolescents is high school with the total of 33 respondents (53.2%). Conclusion: The level of knowledge of teenage daughters about early marriages in the category is sufficient.
