SUMMARY

Background: Landslides are a type of natural disaster that frequently occurs in mountainous areas, especially during the rainy season. In Indonesia, 183 landslides were recorded in 2024. In Central Java, 233 landslides were recorded in 2023. In Karanganyar Regency, 62 landslides occurred between 2023 and 2024, including one school affected: SMP N 1 Jenawi Karanganyar. The limited knowledge of students regarding the types of disasters, early warning signs, and steps to be taken in emergency situations. Increasing knowledge about landslide preparedness can be done by providing education through video media. **Objective:** To increase junior high school students' knowledge about landslide preparedness. **Method:** Video is used to provide information and increase junior high school students' knowledge about landslide preparedness. **Results:** The KIE media, a video titled "Let's Be Prepared for Landslide Disasters" with a duration of 05:36 minutes and a file size of 170.6 MB, has been tested on 3 middle school student respondents. The results show that the video is interesting and easy to understand. **Conclusion:** It is hoped that video media will make it easier to convey information about landslide preparedness to junior high school students and apply it in their daily lives to minimize the occurrence of landslides.
