

**DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY KNOWLEDGE AND ATTITUDES  
TOWARDS VOLCANIC ERUPTION DISASTERS IN JRAKAH SELO  
VILLAGE BOYOLALI**

***Background:** Volcanic eruptions are part of volcanic activity known as “eruptions”. Boyolali Regency is one of the regencies prone to volcanic eruptions in Central Java Province. Especially in Dukuh Sepi Jarakah Selo Boyolali. Dukuh Sepi has the most noticeable impact when a volcanic eruption occurs, both in terms of health, psychological, and economic impacts. **Objective:** To determine the description of community knowledge and attitudes towards volcanic eruptions in Jarakah Village, Selo, Boyolali. **Method:** This study uses a quantitative descriptive design with a survey approach. A total of 79 respondents were selected using the Stratified Random Sampling method from the population of RT 3 and RT 5 Dukuh Sepi. **Results:** The majority of respondents have a good level of knowledge about volcanic eruption disasters (63.3%) and the majority of respondents have a high attitude towards volcanic eruption disasters (88.6%). **Conclusion:** The knowledge and attitudes of the Dukuh Sepi RT 3 and RT 5 communities have a good level of knowledge and a high level of attitude towards volcanic eruptions.*
