COMMUNITY PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION IN RISK LANDSLIDE REGION IN DUSUN TRITIS LENCOH VILLAGE KECAMATAN SELO KABUPATEN BOYOLALI

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ABSTRACT

Background: Landslides are a disaster that often occurs in the highlands and can cause losses. Preparedness behavior is one way to reduce negative impacts in the event of a disaster. Preparedness is an effort / action taken to anticipate the occurrence of disasters with the aim of reducing the number of casualties, injuries, property losses and changing patterns life of citizens. Preparedness is supported by several indicators, namely knowledge and attitudes, emergency response plans, disaster warning systems and resource mobilization. **Objective:** To find out the description of community preparedness in landslide-prone areas in Tritis, Lencoh, Selo, Boyolali. Method: Descriptive research, data retrieval technique with proportional stratified random sampling, sample of 60 respondents, questionnaire research instrument. **Results**: the result from the analysis univariat that the level of knowledge about disaster risk was quite good (80%), attitudes toward disaster risk were good (66.7%) and quite good (33.3%), emergency response plans were good (45%), disaster warning systems were poor (85%) and resource mobilization is not good (73.3%). Conclusion: the people at Tritis village havelevel of knowledge is good enough, good attitude, good emergency response plan, disaster warning system is not good, resource mobilization is not good and the preparedness index is in the almost ready category.
