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DESCRIPTION OF THE POST DISASTER LEVEL OF ANXIETY LANDSCREEN IN DUSUN GUNTUR NGARGOYOSO

ABSTRACT

Background: The happening of Disasters in the world reached 3751 incidents in 2018, while in Indonesia, it was about 2175 incidents, Karanganyar itself experience 59 landslides in 2017. Disasters not only cause loss of property, loss of life and damage to buildings, but disasters also cause psychological effects, such as in anxiety that occurs after the landslide. The level of anxiety after the disaster was found to be the result that the majority of residents had a severe level of 40%. Objective: To determine the level of anxiety after a landslide in Guntur village, Ngargoyoso. Method: Descriptive research by collecting some samples using stratified random sampling technique, with a total sample of 148 respondents, while the research instrument used the Halminton Anxiety Rating Scale questionnaire. While data analysis using univariate analysis. Results: Characteristics of respondents based on the age of respondents in Guntur village, Ngargoyoso had the majority of age 56-65 years, they were graduated from elementary school, mostly they worked as farmers, most of them were female, and Muslims. Most of the respondents experience high level of anxiety The level of anxiety of the majority of respondents experienced anxiety that is 52.4%. Conclusion: majority of residents in Guntur Village, Ngargoyoso experienced high levels of anxiety after the landslide.
