<b>COMPLIANCE VISIT OBEDIENCE OF PREGNANT WOMEN IN PUSKESMAS KARANGTENGAH WORKING AREA WONOGIRI REGENCY</b>	
<b>ABSTRACT</b>	
<p><b>Background;</b> ANC is pregnancy examination for pregnant women during their pregnancy period. ANC services that are carried out regularly and comprehensively can detect abnormalities and risk that may arise during pregnancy, so that these abnormalities and risks can be dealt with quickly and precisely. <b>Goal;</b> Find out and analyze the relation between knowledge and pregnant women's attitude towards ANC visit obedience in Puskesmas Karangtengah working area, Wonogiri Regency. <b>Method;</b> Non experimental research with analytic method by using Cross Sectional Design. Sampling was taken by Purposive Sampling Technique by using 74 pregnant women as the research sampel and using questioner as the research instrument. Bivariate Analysis by using Chi Square Test. <b>Result;</b> The bivariate test result shows that pregnant women knowledge is related to the ANC visit obedience (<math>p_{value} 0,040 &lt; 0,05</math>), and pregnant women attitude is related to the ANC visit obedience (<math>p_{value} 0,000 &lt; 0,05</math>). <b>Conclusion;</b> There is a relation between knowledge and attitude to the ANC visit obedience in Puskesmas Karangtengah working area, Wonogiri Regency.</p>
